LOCK IT UP

Firearm owners have the critical responsibility to ensure that weapons are stored safely, out of the reach of children at all times.



5.4 million children live in a home with a least one unlocked and loaded firearm.

GUIDELINES FOR SAFE GUN STORAGE



Firearms should be **LOCKED** up (using a lock box, cable lock or gun safe) in a location that is completely inaccessible to children in the home.



Ammunition should be stored in an inaccessible location **SEPARATE** from the firearm.



Double, triple, quadruple check to be sure the gun is **UNLOADED** before put into storage.

Children as young as 2 years old may be strong enough to pull the trigger of a firearm.
